



School Consultation

Our School Consultation Clinic runs every Thursday during term time. It is an opportunity for schools to discuss cases via video call with members of the team. There are two appointment sessions each week:

3.30 till 4.15 OR 4.15 till 5

A school consultation could be useful for the following:

- To discuss a young person and decide whether a referral to SCAN would be appropriate.
- To discuss a young person who has been referred to SCAN and whose difficulties are mainly evident in school. To share ideas and explore possible strategies
- To share ideas and explore strategies for a young person who is already known to SCAN

Aims to provide schools with access to SCAN quickly and effectively in order to promote collaborative working
